Program Planning and Counselling

The Student Services Centre is open from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday to Friday and 6:30 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Monday to Thursday. Experienced counsellors are available to help students with their college plans.

Students are advised to plan their courses well in advance of registration and to take advantage of all counselling services offered.

Official enquiries about admission, records, and standing should be directed to Dr. J. J. Denholm, Vice-Principal, Student Services.

Students who require guidance will have the opportunity to consult with counsellors in the registration area at the time of registration.

MATURE STUDENT ENTRY

Students proceeding on diploma programs will be required to complete the College Preparatory Program or its equivalent, unless secondary school completion is waived on a mature-entry basis.

Instructions Prior to Entering Registration Area

IMPORTANT!

- Registration is not complete until fees have been paid.
- Post-dated cheques will not be accepted.
- If fees are to be paid by an agency, department of government, or trust company, a letter of authority for invoicing is required at the time of registration.

RETURNING STUDENTS who have attended Vancouver City College before have been assigned a permanent registration number at a previous registration.

BRING WITH YOU TO REGISTRATION:

1. Statement of Marks.
2. Money for fees.

Your Statement of Marks is your permit to register for the Spring Term, 1968. Your Statement of Marks must be presented for admission to the registration area, January 3, 4 or 5, 1968. A copy of your College transcript may be substituted for a lost Statement of Marks. Transcripts may be obtained from the Student Services Centre in advance of registration (fee 50c).

IMPORTANT!

(1) You may register after the time assigned your group, but not before.

(2) Students registering for evening classes only at the King Edward Centre, and who are unable to register dur-

ing the regular registration time, may register at the Centre on the evenings of Monday, January 8, 1968, and Tuesday, January 9, 1968.

(3) With the exception of students described in (2) immediately above, registrations for the Spring Term, 1968, will close at 4:15 p.m. on Friday, January 5, 1968.

YOUR REGISTRATION TIME IS DETERMINED BY YOUR PERMANENT REGISTRATION NUMBER.

NEW STUDENTS who have not attended Vancouver City College before, register on Friday, January 5. Registration admission tickets bear a **PERMANENT REGISTRATION NUMBER**. *Your permanent registration number is important!* It remains with you throughout your college career. It is used for identification and location of marks, for permanent records, and for computer processing of information. Prospective new students should wait in the cafeteria until their permanent number is paged. The first group called will be numbered 681-0001 to 681-0050; the second, 681-0051 to 681-0100, and so on.

BRING WITH YOU TO REGISTRATION:

1. Ticket of admission (from counsellors).
2. Transcript of your secondary record and other appropriate educational documents.
3. Money for fees (or letter if sponsored by agency).

TECHNICAL STUDENTS RETURNING

Students enrolling for the full 2nd or 4th term schedule of technical subjects as outlined in this Supplement will appear for registration as follows:

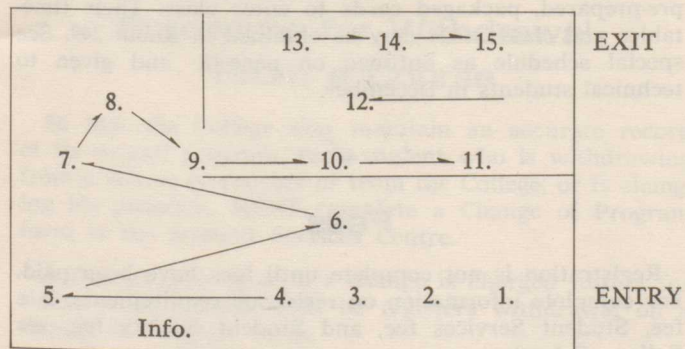
1. Students seeking a mid-year start in an additional subject (e.g. a college prep. course) are to arrange an appointment with Miss Winskill in the Main Office before December 29.
2. Students with "F", "W" or "I" on Fall Term results *must report to Room 249 on Friday, December 29*, so that corrected cards can be drawn prior to registration. The Statement of Marks for the Fall Term must be presented.

—9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
—All technical students refer to schedule distributed in classes in December.

Procedure Within Registration Area

Scheduling

Course offerings are subject to change. Projections in the registration area will show class sections closed and new sections opened. It is the responsibility of the student to enrol in courses which fit a desired program. Should conflicts occur, alternative courses or timetables must be considered.

Instructors' names are offered for the convenience of students. Section changes are permitted only in exceptional circumstances.

Students accepted for technical programs will receive pre-prepared, packaged cards to enter class. Their timetables and class cards may be obtained in Room 249. See special schedule as outlined on page 18 and given to technical students in December.

Fees

Registration is not complete until fees have been paid. For complete information on residence requirements, late fee, Student Services fee, and Student Society fee, see Change College Calendar.

Students will be excluded from classes if the college is notified of a dishonored cheque for fee-payment. Permission may be granted to return to classes effective on payment of all outstanding obligations to the college.

TEXTBOOKS

BOOK RENTAL REGULATIONS

Textbooks are available for most college preparatory courses. The rental fee is \$5.00. Students are advised to consider the cost of purchasing books if registered in only one college preparatory course. Books returned at the end of the Spring Term may make the student eligible for a small refund.

COLLEGE FEES (FALL TERM)

College Arts and Science Program:
\$20 per course to a maximum of \$100.

College Preparatory Program (day):
\$20 per course to a maximum of \$100.

College Technical Programs:
\$20 per course to a maximum of \$75.
The lab fee surcharge in the Art and Merchandising program is \$15.

Non-resident fee — Applicable for 3:30 p.m. - 10:00 p.m. attendance — \$5 per course, in addition to regular course fee.

Late fee — If permission granted for enrolment — \$2 per course.

Student Services fee — Applies to students registered for four or more courses — \$2 per term.

Student Society Fee — Applies to all students—\$1 per term.

Procedure for Withdrawal From a Course

So that the College may maintain an accurate record of its overall program, each student who is withdrawing from a course or courses or from the College, or is changing his program, MUST complete a Change of Program form at the Student Services Centre.

A student making such a change is charged tuition for a course or courses until he registers withdrawal on a Change of Program form.

Refunds are based on the scale as set out on Page 19 of the College Calendar.

This procedure is effective for the Spring Term beginning January 8, 1968.
