

. Here is a recipe for pumpkin pie.

1 tin pumpkin

3/4 teaspoon salt

1 teaspoon cinnamon

½ teaspoon mace

3/4 teaspoon ginger and a little cloves

3/4 cup brown sugar

2 eggs

1/2 cup cream

3/4 cup of milk (scalded)

Directions: 1. Put pumpkin, salt, spices and brown sugar together. Mix well.

- 2. Beat eggs a little, add cream. Beat again.
- 3. Stir egg mixture into pumpkin mixture.
- 4. Add milk and stir.
- 5. Pour into uncooked pie shell.

Bake in 450 degree oven for 20 minutes. Reduce heat to 350 degrees and bake for 30 to 35 minutes longer.

We miss you very much. We hope you are having a good time. We hope your daughter is feeling better. When will you come back?


Did you have a good time at the Taiwan Festival? We had family parties here.
