# Photo ID at KEC/City Centre

There is no charge for the Photo ID. However, if the student loses their ID card, replacement cards cost \$10, payable to the cashiers office.

All cards come with an expiry date. Students that need a new expiry sticker can obtain them from the cashiers office at either campus. Cards are available to students registered in the Banner System after January 1999. Cards are not available to Program Development and Continuing Education Students at this


