Program admission requirements

- Bachelor degree
- 1st year English with a C+ or better

Applicants whose first language is other than English, who are presenting foreign documents must achieve the following scores on one of the following English Proficiency tests:

- IELTS overall band 6.5, with no band lower than 6.0, with a minimum score of 6.5 in speaking & listening
- VCC ELA total: 145/200
 - ✦ Reading: 50/70
 - ✦ Essay: 17/20
 - ✦ Listening: 27/30
 - ✦ Speaking: 27/30
- TOEFL IBT 88 with no score lower than 22
