

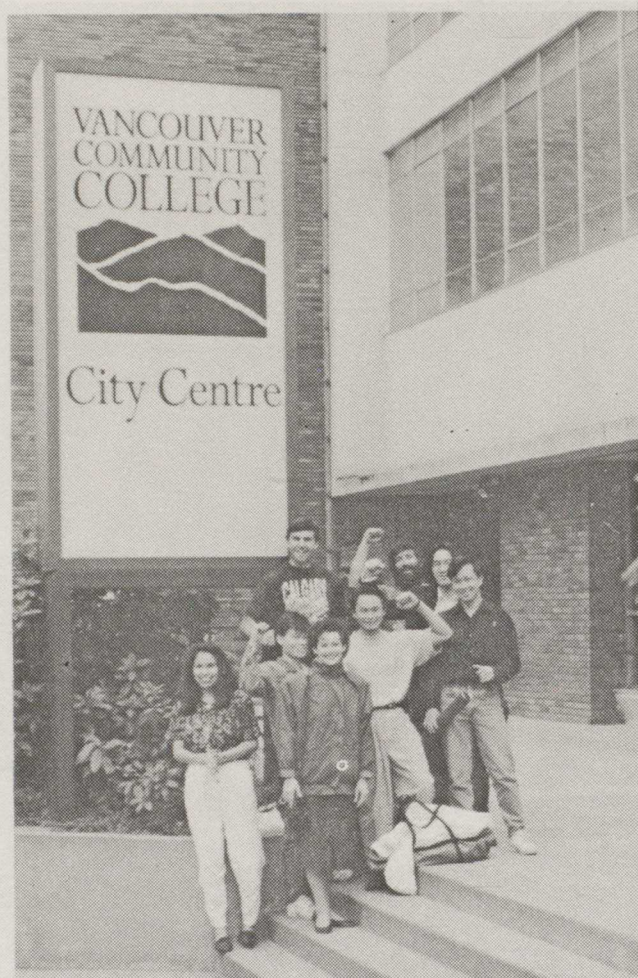

The New Look!



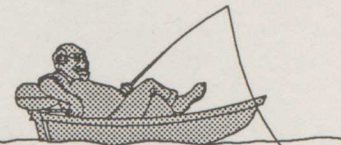
A group of happy students help celebrate City Centre's new look with the arrival of the new signs.

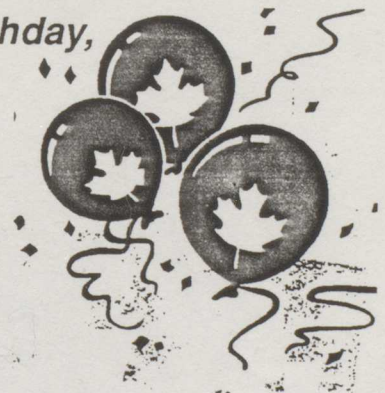
