7) INSTRUCTOR'S DIPLOMA OR EQUIVALENT

Dale Jones, Director of Personnel and Labour Relations, in a letter to Al Stusiak of the V.I.A., on January 18, 1977, referring to the understandings of a meeting held on Monday December 20, 1976 wrote:

"The following constitutes our understandings regarding the above.

No changes to the provisions of the Collective Agreement to be made at this time. It was clarified, however, that instructors who have not completed the I.D. program may re-submit their credentials to the appropriate Centre Principal vis-a-vis the appropriate equivalency".

Any instructor wishing to re-submit credentials, transcripts or any other documents relating to any equivalent programs or courses taken, is invited to re-submit them to Mr. Monasch.

9) INSTRUCTING ADULTS - A WORKING SEMINAR

Vancouver Community College, through C.E.S. is offering a two day working seminar designed especially to give assistance to those instructors actively involved in teaching adults, on February 4 and 5.
