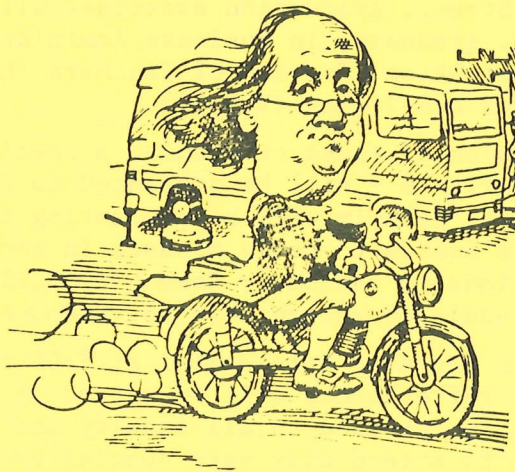
2-a) OUR PERIPATETIC HARRY
