Application deadline is November 18, 1977. For details, please see notice on Faculty bulletin board.

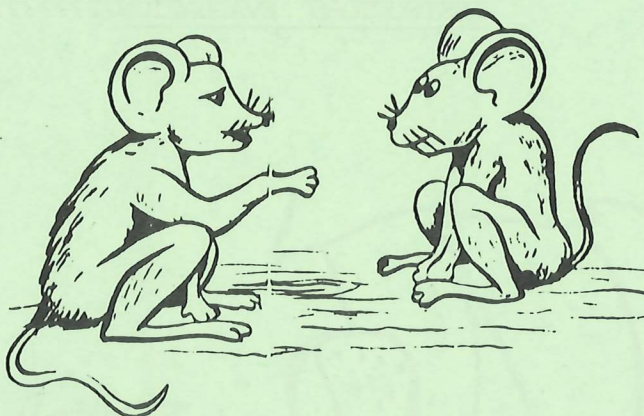
