"I heard the heavens are going to fall," said the sparrow.

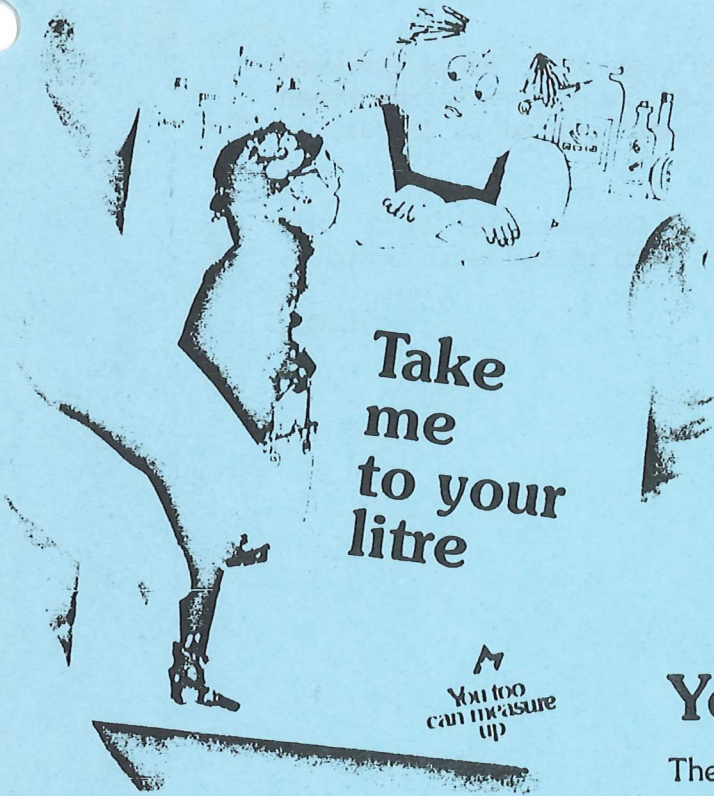
"Oh," said the horseman. "And I suppose your puny legs can hold them up?"

milligram **mg**

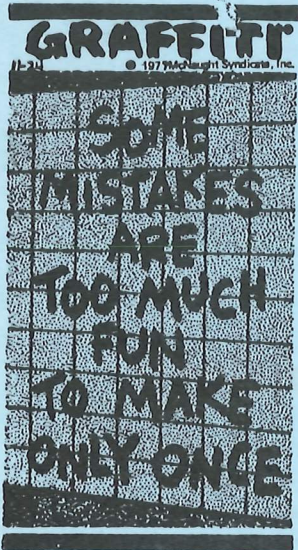
You are most likely to run across milligrams in your pharmacy—prescription drugs, household remedies.
