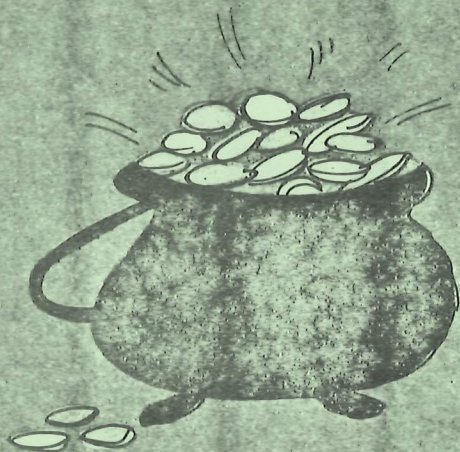

9) CENTRE FOR THE STUDY OF ADMINISTRATION IN EDUCATION, U.B.C.

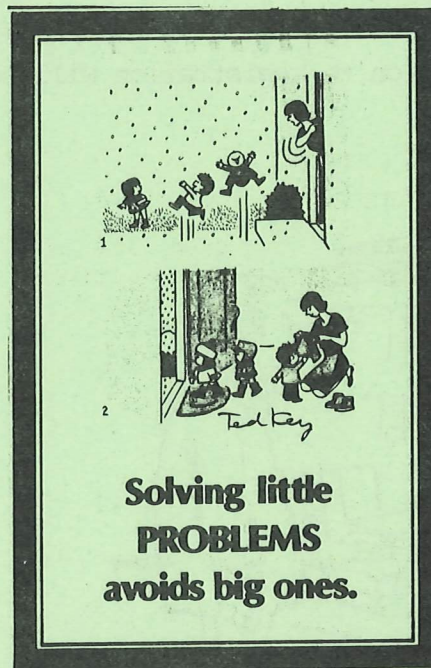
Part two of the 1978 short course in post-secondary administration is scheduled for April 6th and 7th. Details are posted on the bulletin board.
