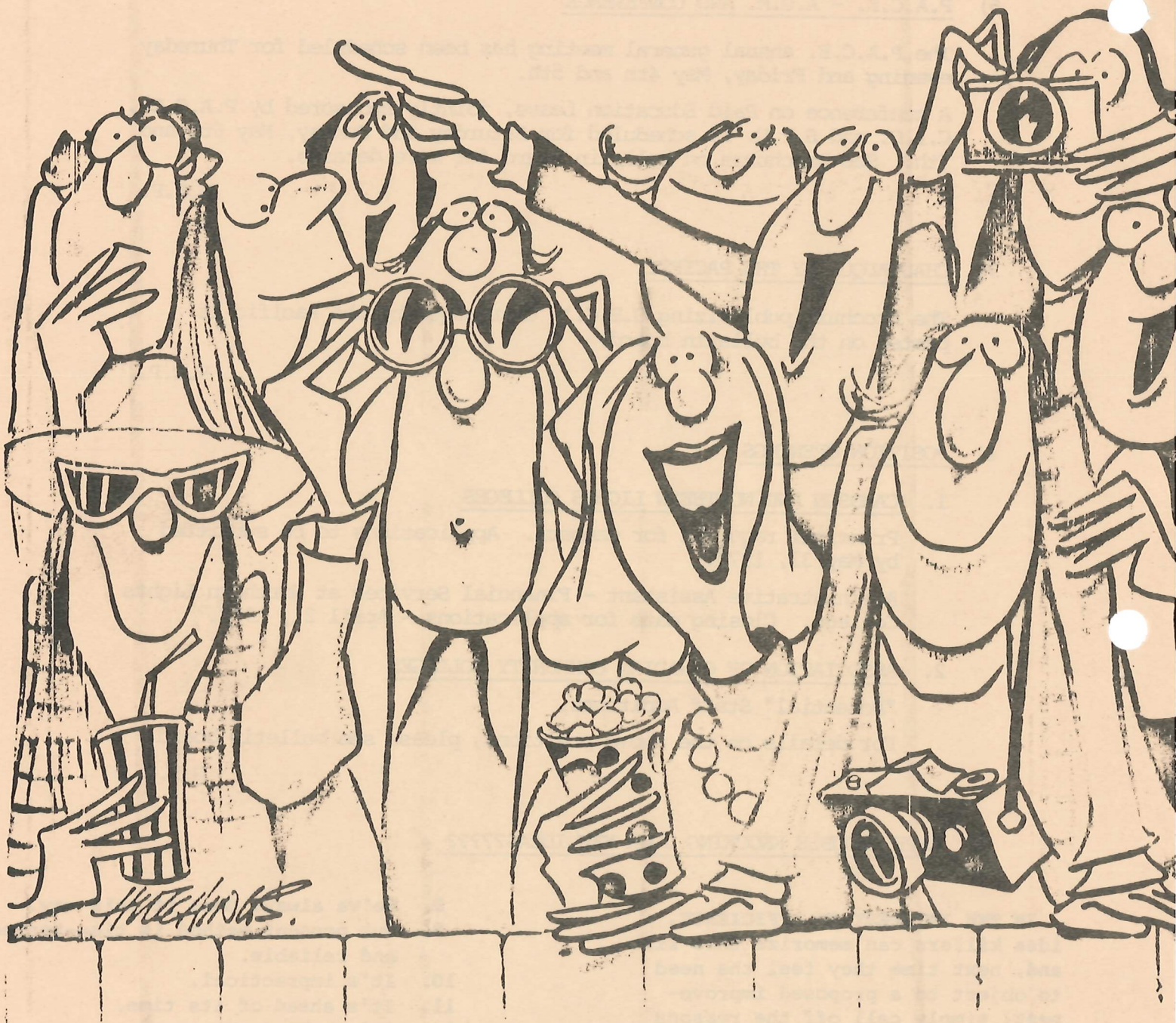
1. Our problem is different.
