1) COLLEGE COUNCIL

The College Council met in public session on Wednesday. Among the items discussed, the following may be of interest to faculty and staff at this Campus:

College Principal, A. S. Manera, reported -

- a) that the Ministry has requested colleges and institutes to prepare 5-year budget precasts;
- b) that the Ministry has approved \$600,776 as V.C.C.'s 1978-79 furniture and equipment capital budget - we had requested \$1,319,537;
- c) that the West Eighth Avenue lease is still before the Treasury Board;
- d) that the Ministry has approved the College Council's request for \$60,000 for pre-planning purposes;
- e) that R. B. Howard, Architect, and architectural programmers APRA and Graham Brown Associates have been retained for the pre-planning tasks.

Council heard reports from Dr. Kennedy on recent meetings of the Executive Committees of MAC and BCAC.

Council declined to pay a VSB invoice for \$40,000 for work done at Langara by the VSB in 1970.

Minutes of last month's Council meeting - as well as background material related to most of the above - have been placed in the Library.
