6) HAPPY HOLIDAY!

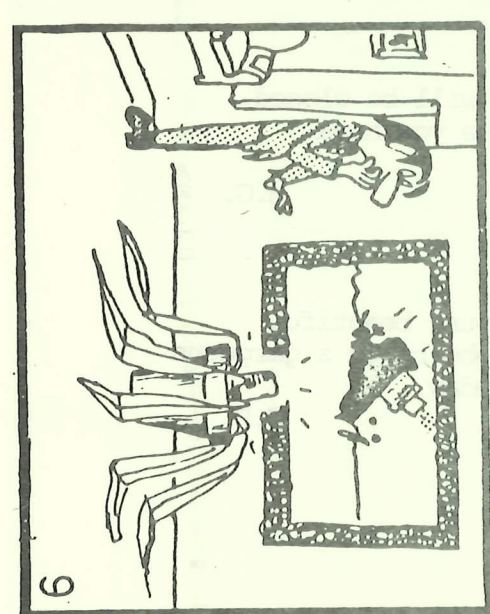
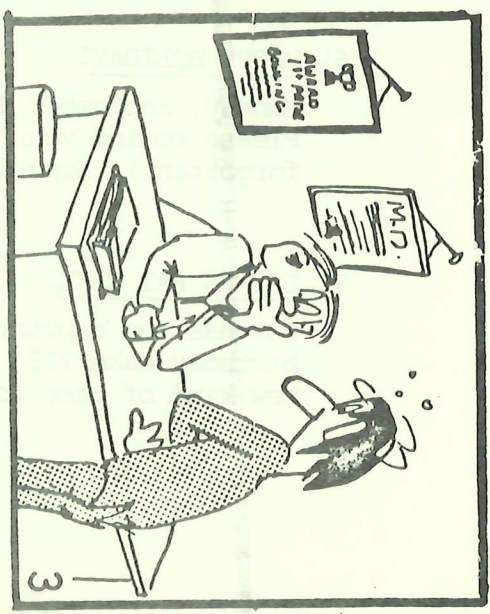
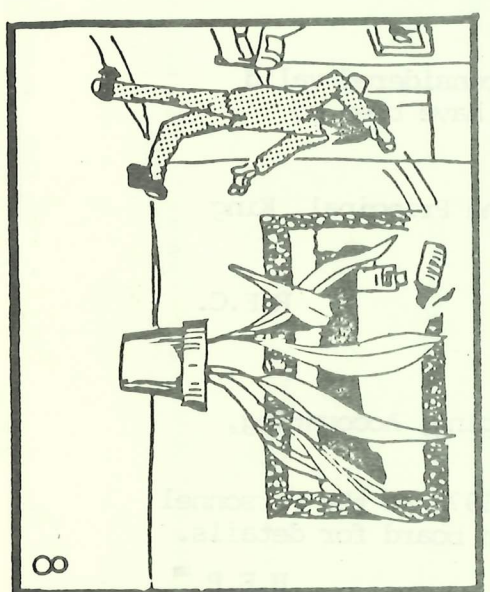
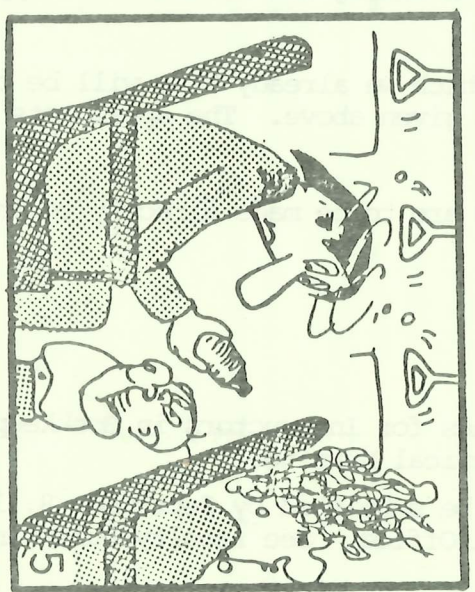
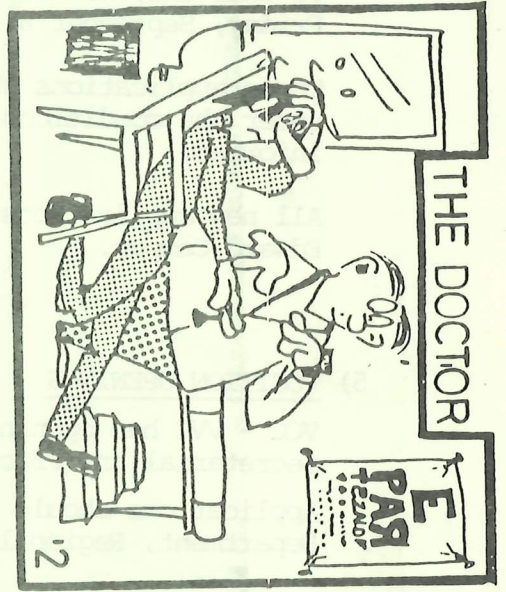
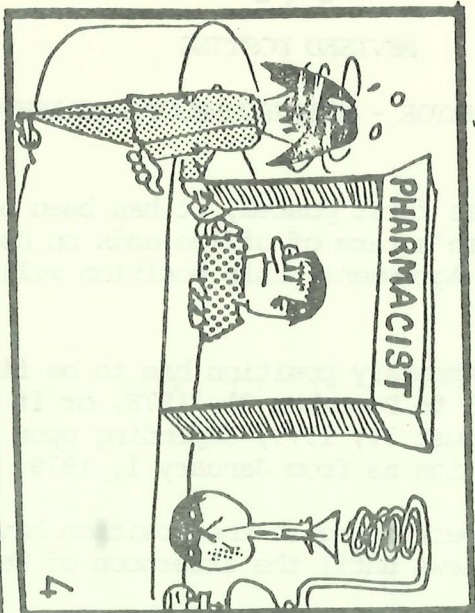
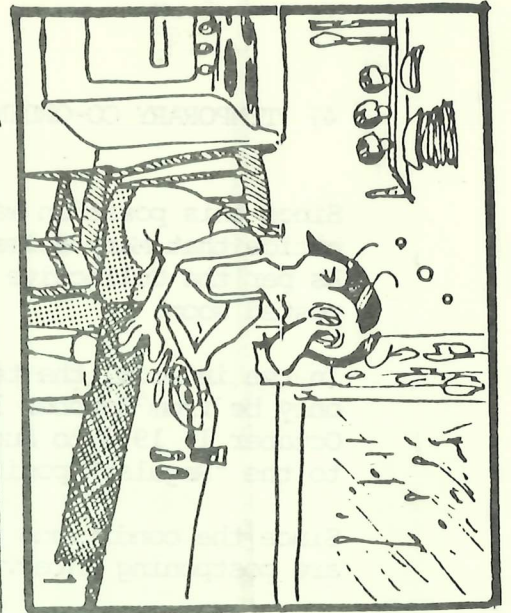
