### PRONUNCIATION

"The Advanced Pronunciation Courses are designed for students, who know grammar, vocabulary, and can read, to communicate more clearly with English-speaking people, but most advanced students do not realize their importance.

In pronunciation classes we can learn many skills which are how to make the sounds of English, accent, rhythm, the feeling of sounds that sometimes make meanings different and so on. The teachers try to make the students speak naturally as a Canadian, and they teach them individually. The maximum number of students is twelve, so that we can have a lot of time to especially practice what we have learned.

According to some of the English-second-language teachers I have met, most advanced students should take the program if they wish to make good progress in English."

### 11) VACATION FOR ROSEMARY MEYER


