SUBJECT: FINAL RESULTS 1979 CAMPAIGN


Although there may be a few more contributions trickle in, the attached figures are the last I intend to circularize.

Overall, the contributions this year are up 79.7% over last year and the number of participants is up 183%. This is an excellent result and I want to thank you all for the time and effort you have devoted to the success of the campaign.

Included in this report are participation rates for the four campaigns. The number for your centre will probably not be exactly the same as the number you have been using because I have attempted to arrive at an appropriate full-time equivalency. Included in this will be numbers of Library, Audio Visual and Computer Services employees and excluded are employees contracted by other organizations such as cleaning and security staffs. The result is a drop in our total number of employees from an even 1,000 to 910. This has some positive effect on our participation rate (18.4% becomes 20.2%) but it is a correction I felt should be made to more properly reflect the contribution the College is making to the United Way Campaign.

While I do not have this year's figures from other institutions you might be interested to note that last year S.F.U.'s participation rate was 19%, U.B.C. was 15% and B.C.I.T. was 11%. The colleges were well back.

Again, thank you very much for a job well done.

6) CHARGE-BACK SYSTEM - PRINTING AND DUPLICATING

Because of the ever-increasing costs of paper and the doubling of consumption of paper, it has become necessary to institute a charge-back system for printing and duplicating work. In the past, only major projects (such as a campus-produced workbook or curriculum) have been charged to individual departments. However, since the beginning of the current fiscal year, all work orders are costed and charged back to the departments concerned. This is for supplies only; labor costs are not included.

Faculty and staff are urged to request only the copies actually required, and that wherever possible, work be done back-to-back.

Copies of the charge-backs are distributed to division chairmen and department heads each month.

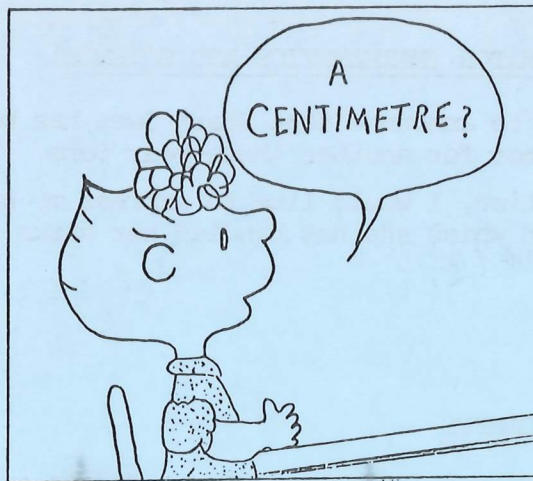

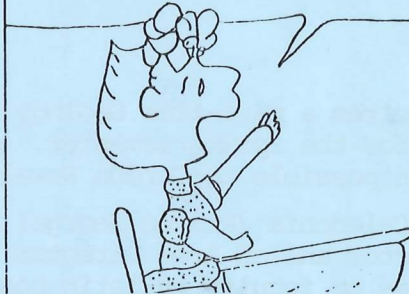
