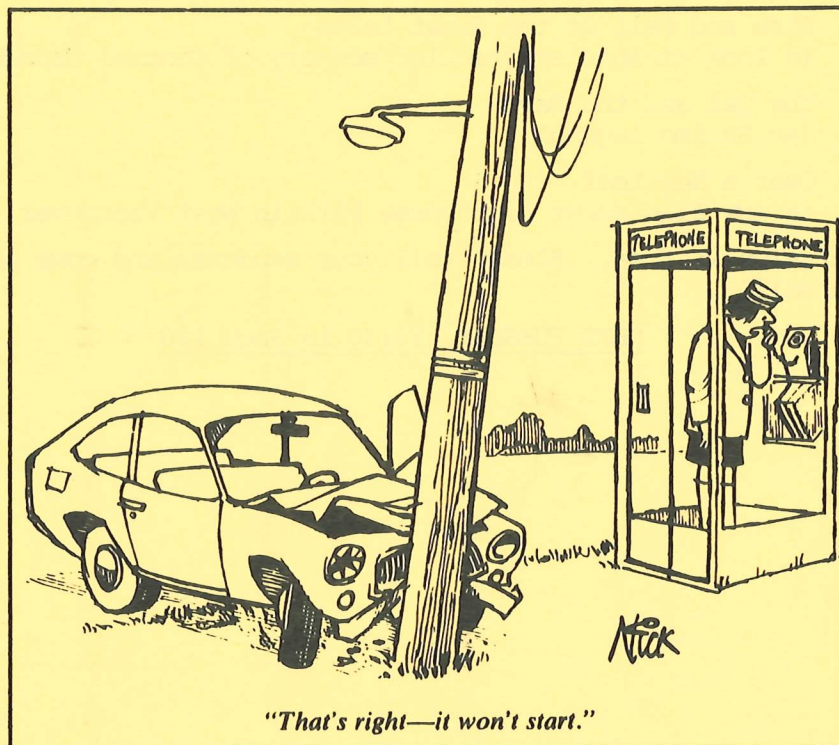
HOLIDAZE!

V.C.C./V.V.I. requires an Industrial Programs Assistant in the Printing Production Department. Closing date for applications is July 14, 1980.

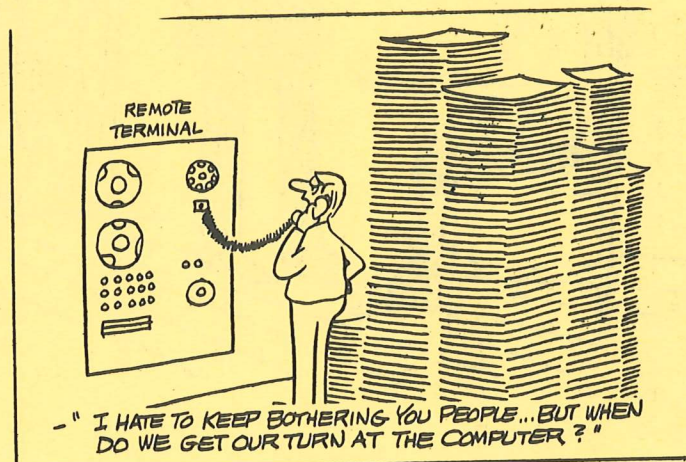
V.C.C./V.V.I. requires a Cafeteria Worker. Closing date for applications is July 14, 1980.

A REMINDER FROM STUDENT HEALTH SERVICES

Student Health Services will be conducting two blood pressure screening days this month. On July 16 from 11:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. and on July 17 from 2:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. in the corridor adjacent to the cafeteria. We (Dr. Rothon and myself) will be taking the blood pressures of any students or staff interested. The objectives of this project are three-fold: To allow the student body and staff to become familiar with health services, to inform students about what is high blood pressure and how it can be prevented, and to identify cases of hypertension and recommend follow-up.

We hope you will assist us in our objectives by encouraging your students to stop by and have their BP taken, or by bringing your class over to see us.
