COLLEGE BOARD MEETING - Wednesday, July 16, 1980

The College Board met on Wednesday. A number of matters were discussed and acted upon, some of which are covered in this report.

College Principal A. S. Manera announced that all the options on the China Creek property have been exercised and the 7.8 acres in question are now owned by Vancouver Community College. Mr. Manera also announced that the previous owner of one of the parcels of land, Mr. and Mrs. Robert McGregor, have pledged \$20,000 to be used for the construction of a child-care facility at the new campus.

The College Board approved preliminary plans respecting the modification of buildings at the Langara Campus.

Respecting "A Draft Policy on the Provision of Adult Basic Education Programs", the College Board passed two motions for submission to the Minister of Education:

"That the colleges be consulted regarding the method of coordination of Adult basic education (and other continuing education) programs" and

"That the setting of tuition fees remain a responsibility of college boards; should such fees, however, be eliminated by legislation or regulation, the resultant loss of income to be made up through an equivalent increase in provincial grants to the institution."

The College Principal's report, the minutes of the previous Board meeting, and materials related to the agenda items have been placed in the library for the perusal of those interested.

The next meeting of the College Board is scheduled for August 20, 1980.
