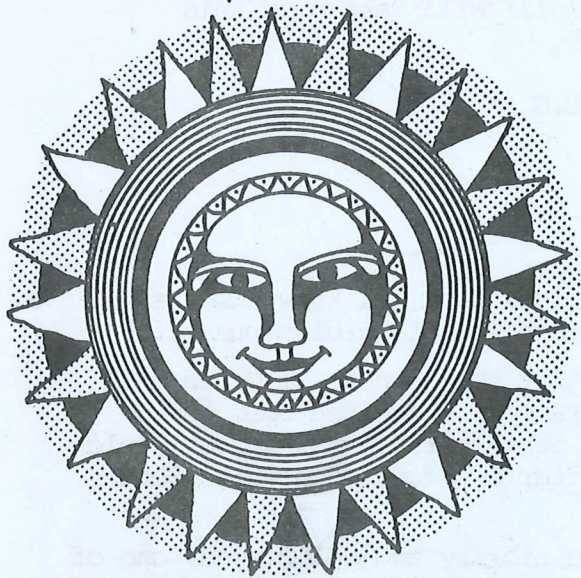

It was with sorrow that I learned that Netje Ramsbottom died of cancer on Monday, July 21st, her forty-ninth birthday.

Mrs. Ramsbottom was a Business Education instructor who first joined the College in 1968 at the King Edward Centre. She moved to the Langara Campus in 1970 and came to King Edward Campus, then Special Programs Division as a charter faculty member in 1971.

During her time as an instructor here she served on the executive of the Vocational Instructors' Association.

After a lengthy sick leave Mrs. Ramsbottom resigned in April 1977
