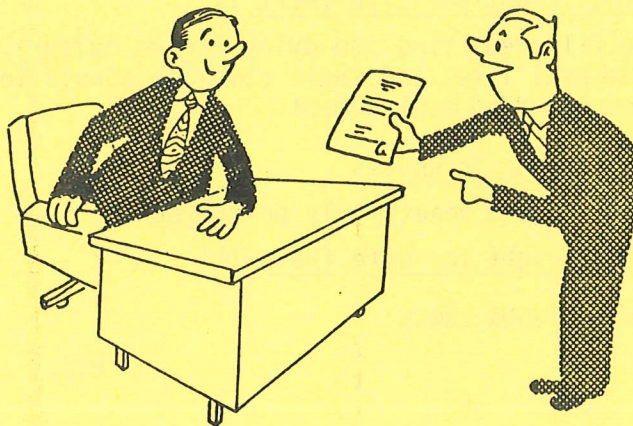

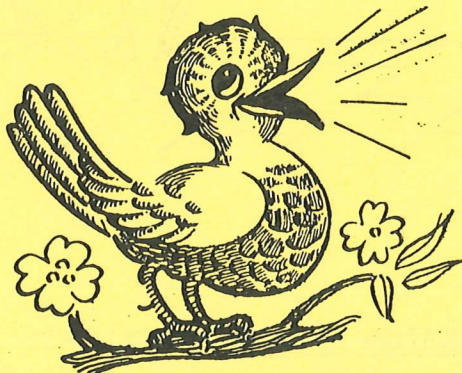

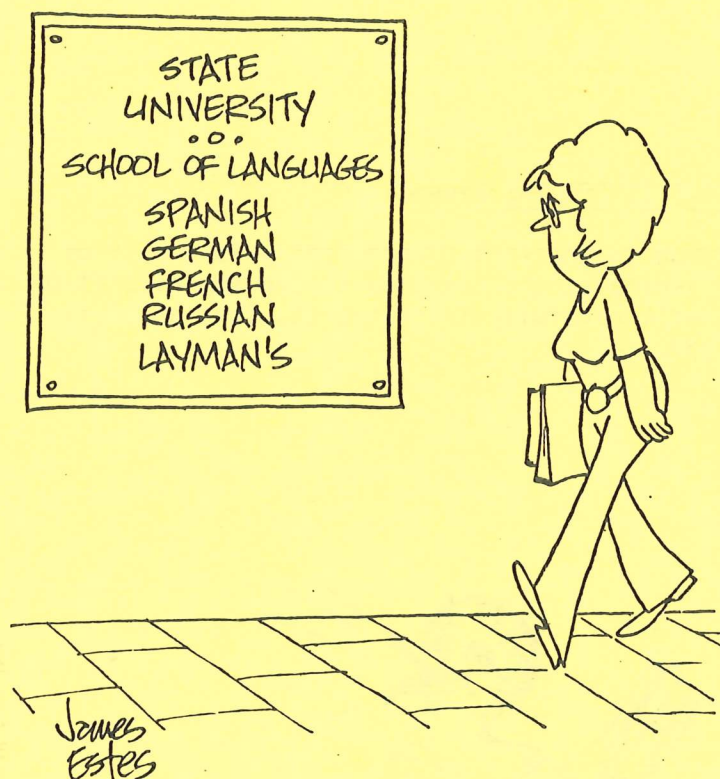
POSITION OPENINGS
