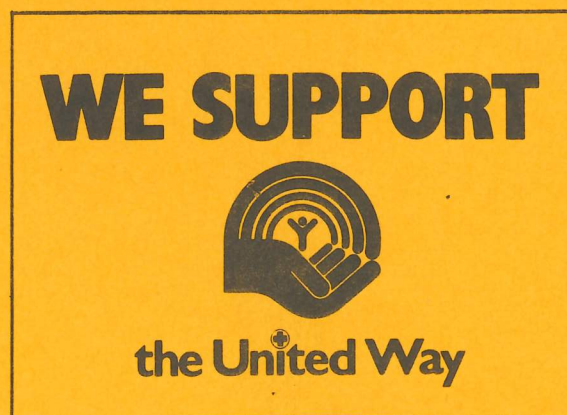

the United Way

Once again it is time to defend the honour of our illustrious Running Club. We have been challenged by the Y.M.C.A. to defend our title at Stanley Park on Saturday, October 23rd at 2:00 p.m.

The main course (approximately 5 miles) will be the same as last year. The Race will start at the parking lot of the Vancouver Rowing Club (near the entrance to Stanley Park) and you can run, walk, bike, skate board (or swim with our College President) around the sea wall to 2nd Beach. Just in case the route was too strenuous last year, we have two alternate routes of 1 1/2 miles and 2 1/2 miles. Route 1 (1 1/2 miles) will start at the Rowing Club, complete one circle of Lost Lagoon and finish at Second Beach. Route 2 (2 1/2 miles) will circle Brockton Point and return via Lumberman's Arch along Lost Lagoon to 2nd Beach.

As before, shower and change facilities are available at the Y.M.C.A. on Burrard Street before and after the race.

The "Victory" and "Special Awards" ceremony will take place at the Century Plaza Hotel, after the Race beginning at approximately 4:00 o'clock. The Hotel is letting us use their restaurant facilities, so we will have privacy and people will be able to get a variety of drinks and food stuffs. It also gives you the option of inviting family members below the LEGAL AGE.

Besides the Golden Sneaker trophies which are awarded to the sneakiest participant on each team, there will be 25 additional prizes awarded by each club (10 team T-shirts and 15 "personal" prizes). In terms of "personal" team prizes we still need some help. For example, Ted Kirby is going to donate one free bike tune-up; Wayne Decle - one free skating or basic ice hockey lesson; Shannon Girvan - one guided spa treatment; David Wong - two free registrations to the famous Khahtsohlano Road Race. If you have any ideas, donations or services to offer, leave your name on the No Name Running Club information board outside of Dave Greenall's office at K.E.C. or with Dalton Kremer, John Spencer or Bill Edwards at V.V.I., with Richard Vedan, Bob Hamoura or Pasquale Pascucci at Langara, Max Fleming at Regional Office or Bob Lajoie at Continuing Education.

This year to give moral as well as financial support to the United Way Campaign, we are going to levy a small charge of \$2.00 per entrant (half of which will go to the United Way, the other \$1.00 will be used to help meet race expenses). The portion of the United Way \$ collected through the Race registration fee credited each centre will be based on the representation from the individual centres (Langara, V.V.I., K.E.C., Regional Office and Continuing Education). In other words, "Thems" with the most participants will get the most \$ credited to their campus United Way total. K.E.C. of course, will win hands down!

The event is open to students, staff, faculty and administration. You do not have to be a super "jock" to take part. A good crawl will suffice. Come out and enjoy yourself. The Race will go on rain or shine.

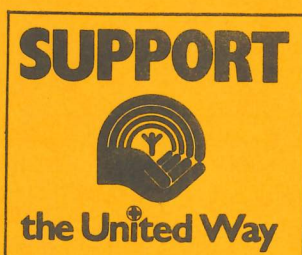
