V.C.C./V.V.I. requires an Assistant Department Head in the Drafting Department. Closing date for applications is May 15.

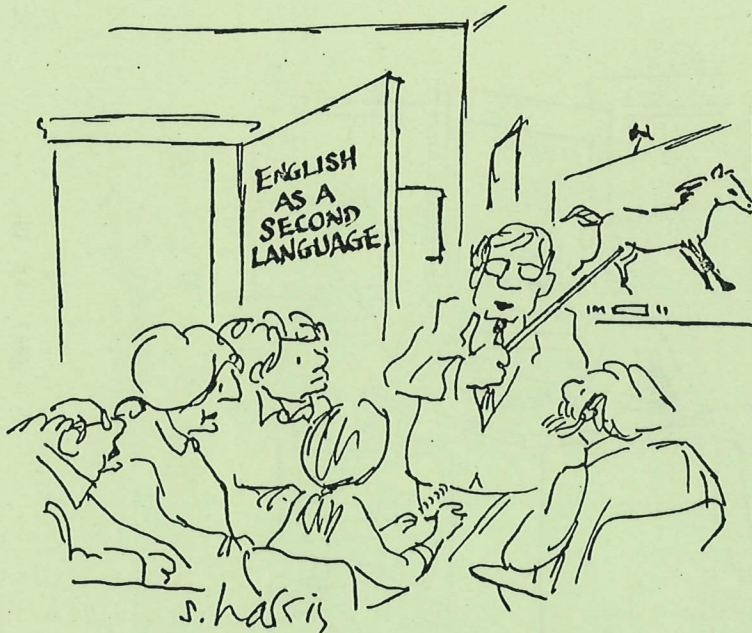
V.C.C. Langara requires a Telephone Operator/Receptionist. Closing date for applications is May 16.
