The following topics were dealt with at yesterday's meeting of the College Board:

4. The Board passed a motion to approve submission of TFC #247 for English Language Training. The funding requested is \$304,101.

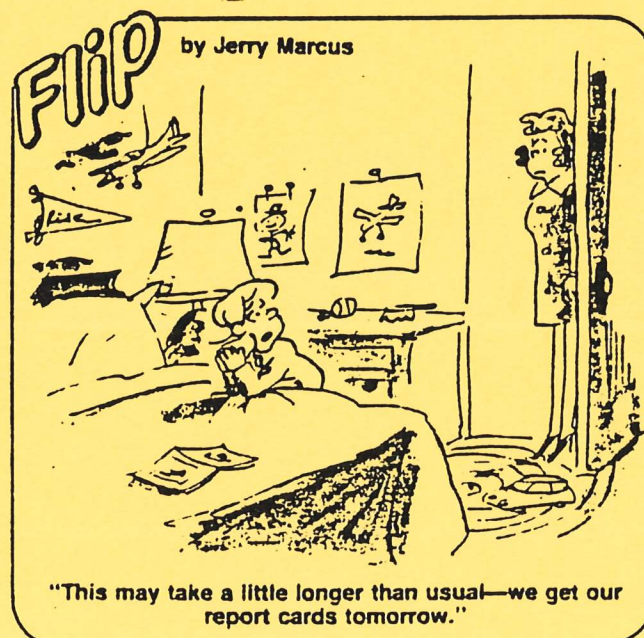

STUDENT BOOK EXCHANGE

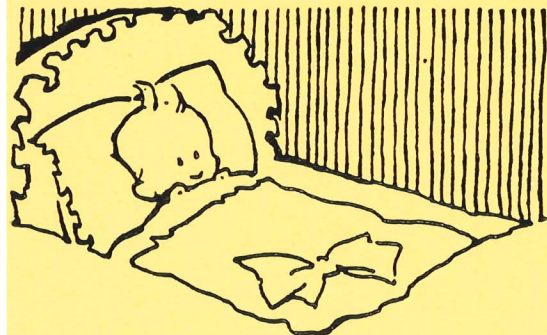
