## NOTES FROM THE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

At the meeting on Monday, 1987 March 16, the members of the Committee addressed the following:

1. A proposal to run, in collaboration with the Continuing Education, a cost-recoverable Musical Theatre Program in May and June. The proposal was approved.
2. Guidelines for Handling Issues Related to AIDS. Members will comment at a future meeting.
3. Reservations for Luncheon at King Edward Day. Coordinators will collect luncheon reservations and the two dollar payment and give them to Shirley Girvan.
4. The first report of the Building Advisory Committee. Recommendations were noted and steps will be made to set priorities and implement, funding being available.
5. Signs. Requests were made for signs on the second and third floors designating the location of classrooms. Alternatives will be examined.
6. Division Chairmen as Directors. Still an open question.
7. KEC Recording. The telephone recording will be changed to reflect times that Campus and its facilities will be open.
8. Institutional Evaluation and Self Study Action Plan. Priority actions to be taken were discussed briefly.
9. Auditors Report on VCC 1987. The major recommendations were discussed.

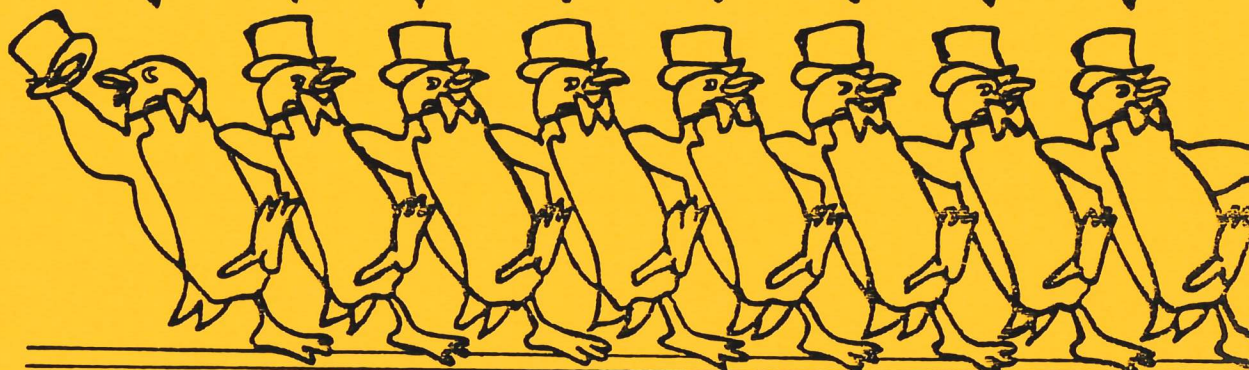
