OVER \$1 MILLION IN GRANTS TO VANCOUVER COMMUNITY COLLEGE ANNOUNCED

The Advanced Education and Job Training Ministry today announced that Vancouver Community College will receive over \$1 million from the Fund for Excellence announced on June 23, 1987.

A unique co-operative venture at the King Edward Campus, which has been achieved by Vancouver Community College and the Native Indian Education Society will be supported by \$330,000 from the fund. This venture affiliates the operation of the Native Indian Education Centre, which is the responsibility of the society, with the operations and instructional programming offered at the College. The funding will enable the Centre to increase the number of students served by 300%.

Vancouver Community College will initiate the first phase of "A Quest for Excellence" with the allocation of \$164,000 from the Fund. New forms for management and decision-making will be tested by a team composed of representatives of the college, private specialists and citizens of the community.

The College expects that this active partnership will generate proposals that will enhance all aspects of college life and, by doing so, enable the College to achieve a level of institutional excellence that will be in tune with future needs.

Almost \$553,000 of the total allocation will be provided for the replacement of capital equipment as well as the acquisition of upgraded computer and laboratory equipment.

"In the past, colleges and institutions held back capital replacement expenditures in order to maintain levels of services," the Ministry said.

Vancouver Community College will be invited to join with the other colleges and institutes to propose priority curriculum development projects that will share the \$600,000 allocated from the Fund for Excellence to upgrade local curricula and modernize apprenticeship courses.

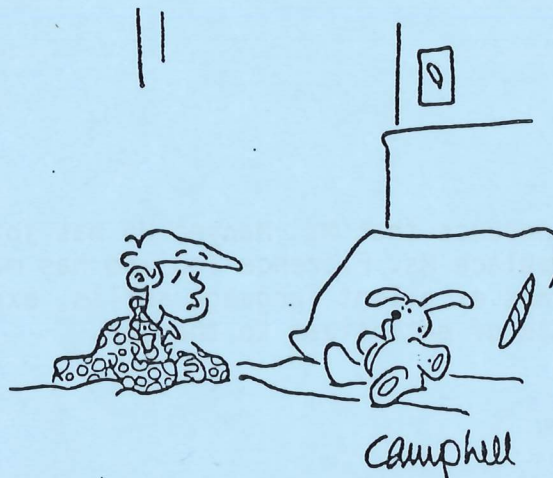
