Come aboard the Brittanica Yacht for an evening cruise.

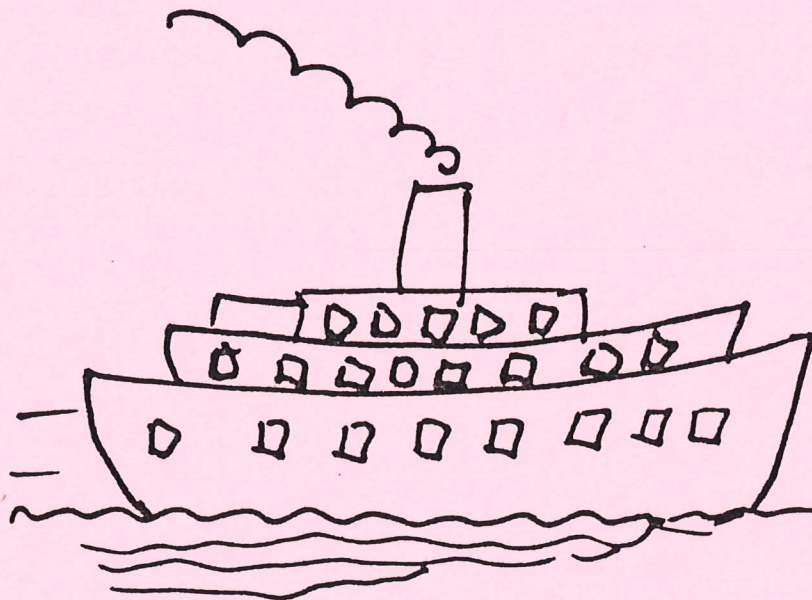
