Subject Christmas and New Year's Days Off - V.M.R.E.U.


I know it's early, however, a number of people have called regarding the above.

As you know, the contract between the College and the Vancouver Municipal and Regional Employees' Union provides that all working days between Christmas and New Year's Day (3 days), exclusive of general holidays and days observed in lieu thereof, will be considered as days of leave with full pay.

Further, should any employee's presence be necessary for the continued operation of the College, the employer shall designate such employee(s) at least one (1) month in advance. Such "designated" employee(s) will work all or part of the days in question, and receive an equivalent number of days off with pay in the following year to be scheduled with the approval of the College.

Boxing Day falls on a Saturday this year. In accordance with the Collective Agreement Monday, December 28, 1987 shall be deemed to be a holiday in lieu thereof.

Please ensure that your subordinate managers/supervisors are aware of the foregoing.

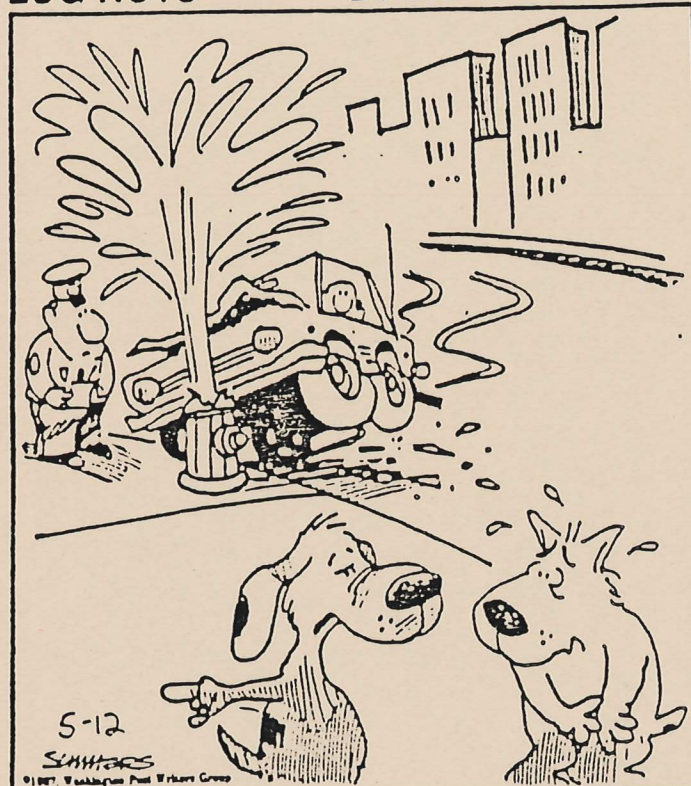
