VANCOUVER INTERNATIONAL MARATHON:

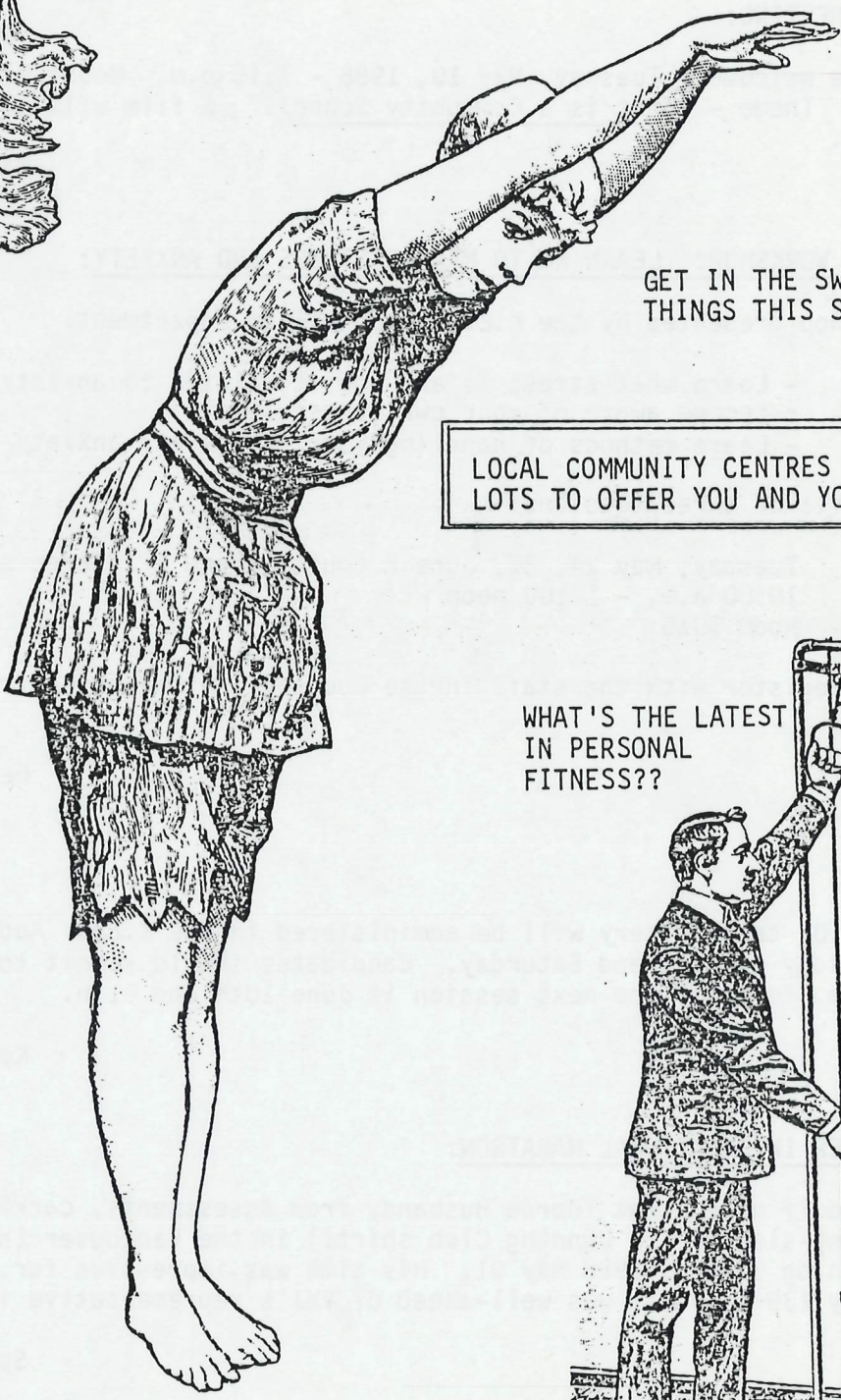

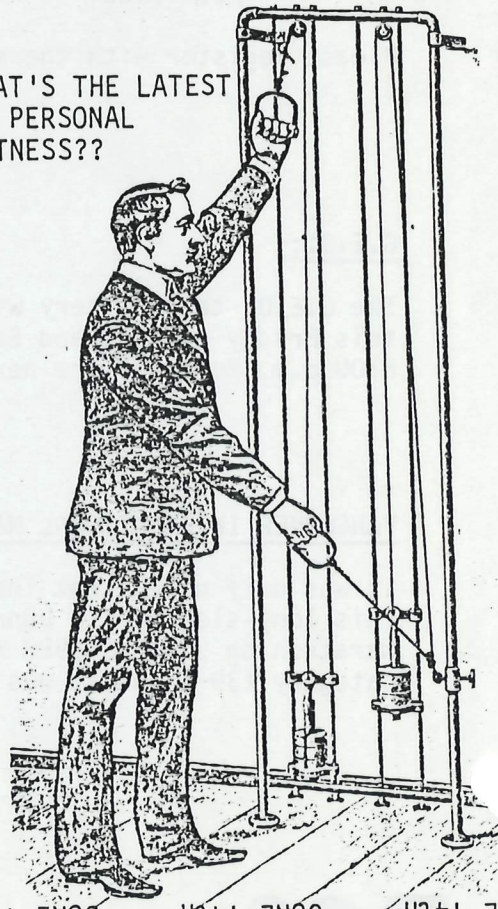
