SCIENCE DEPARTMENT HEAD APPOINTED

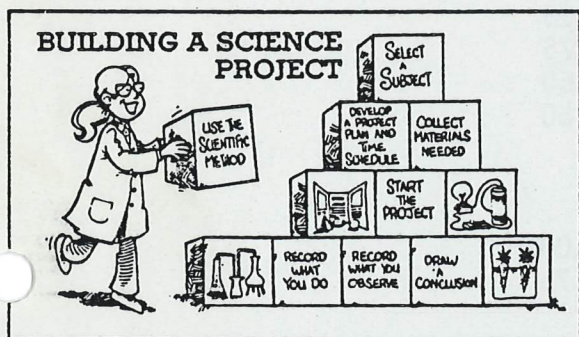

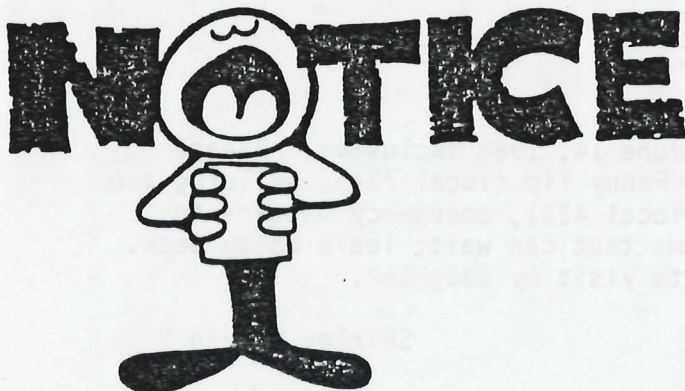


