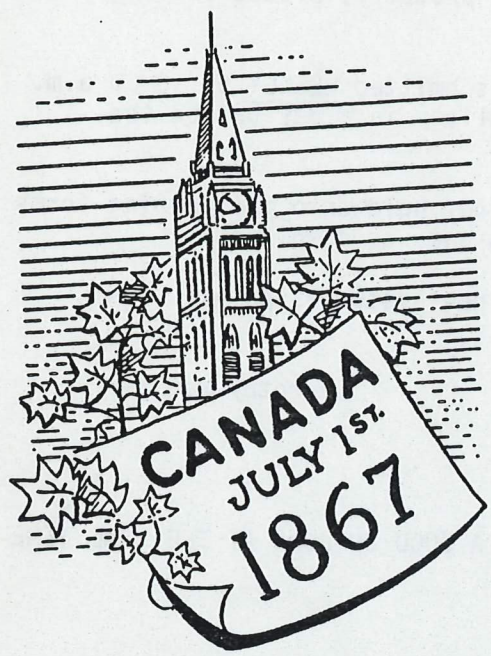

## LUCKY LANGARA:

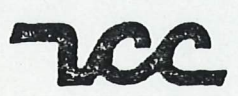

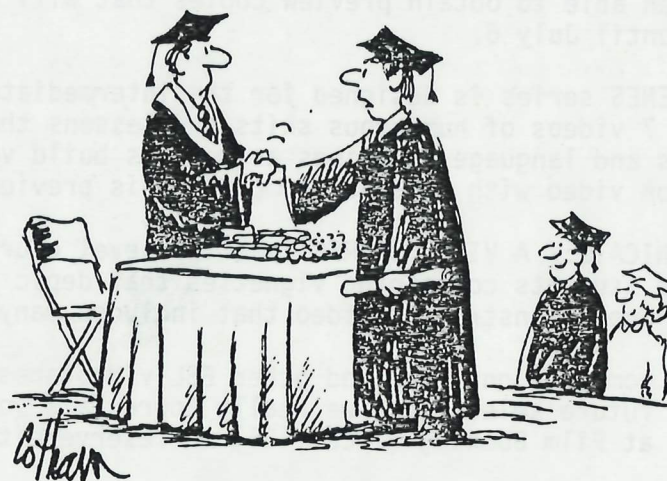
