

Senior professional and administrative posts

The Commonwealth of Learning, a new Agency being established by Commonwealth governments to promote co-operation in distance education, now wishes to appoint initial senior staff—up to four senior professional positions and an administrative/finance officer.

The purpose of the Agency is to promote human resource development in Commonwealth countries by harnessing the potential of distance education on a co-operative basis. Its initial programmes will include exchange and development of teaching materials, promotion of training for staff development and of direct communications links between institutions for teaching and research.

The senior professional posts will be at the level of departmental head; initially reporting direct to the President of the Agency. Two or three posts are likely to focus on distance education co-operation in relation to particular subjects and disciplines and their incumbents will be responsible for identifying needs, locating courses and materials to meet them, arranging access and adaptation, and where necessary promoting the development of new materials for shared use. Likely areas for initial attention include accence/mathematics; accountancy/management; professional areas like health, education, engineering; and agriculture/rural development. Applicants for these posts should have a strong professional base in an appropriate disciplinary area as well as experience of distance education.

Other posts will be orientated to distance education techniques and organisation including promotion of training, application of communications technology in countries whose circumstances vary, consultancy services in developing distance education systems and institutions. Successfut candidates will have experience of the application of distance education methods in more than one country, including developing countries.

The administrative/finance officer will be responsible for developing management procedures and the financial framework for the new organisation and will require experience of public administration and financial management preferably in an international context.
