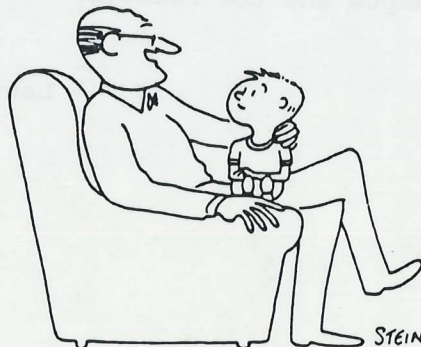
DEPARTMENT HEAD, AUTO MECHANICS
