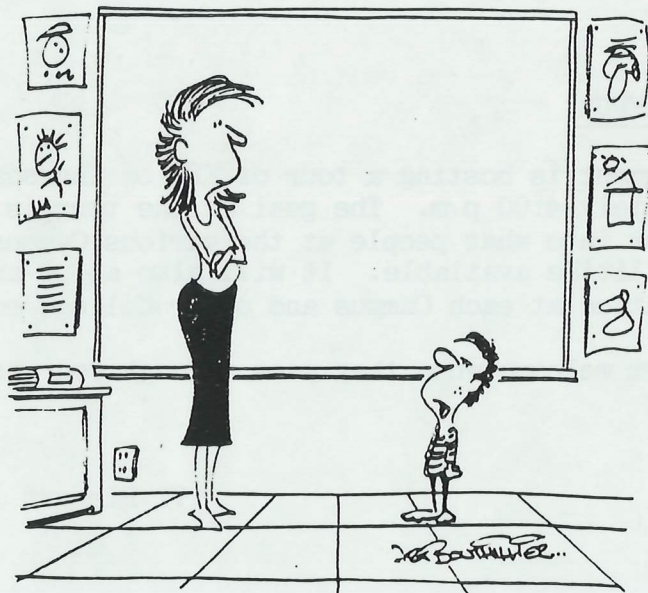

The Association of Canadian Community Colleges (ACCC), a national Canadian non-governmental institution with a membership of 130 colleges and technical institutes and Cégeps in all provinces and territories, requires a Senior Project Officer to fill a challenging position in its international division.

Reporting to the Africa Americas Division Director, the Senior Project Officer will be responsible for the administration of existing, and the initiation of new, institutional strengthening and human resource development projects with the overseas partners of Canadian institutions. The primary focus of the position is our program in Anglophone Africa. Depending on language skills and prior experience, the Project Officer will work with colleagues in other countries of Africa, Latin America or the Caribbean.

Responsibilities - project design, implementation and monitoring; liaison activities with member colleges, CIDA and other funding agencies and overseas institutions and government ministries; the development of regional strategies; provision of leadership at in-Canada development education workshops; and the conduct of project feasibility and evaluation missions.

Qualifications - Graduation from a recognized tertiary educational institution. Minimum 5 years international development involvement including at least two years of relevant overseas work experience. Knowledge of the Canadian post-secondary educational milieu. Fluent English; French or Spanish language skills a definite asset.
