Judging by the requests we get, your colleagues really are interested in seeing your work. Don't disappoint them!

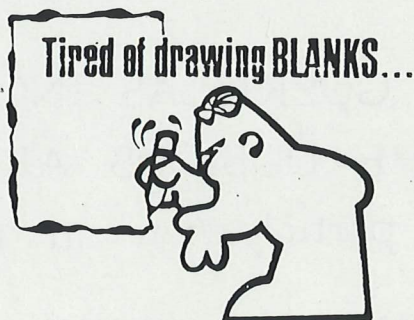
