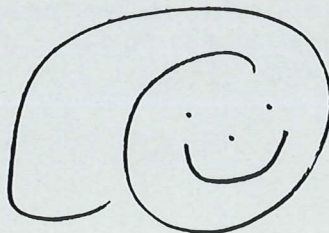
Thank you for your many kind words. The cards brought tears and smiles as I read them.

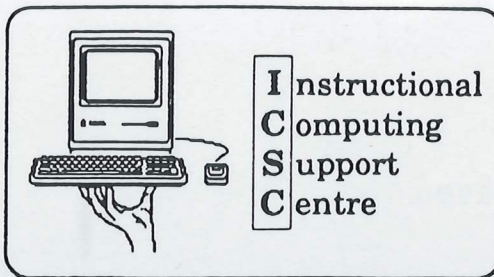

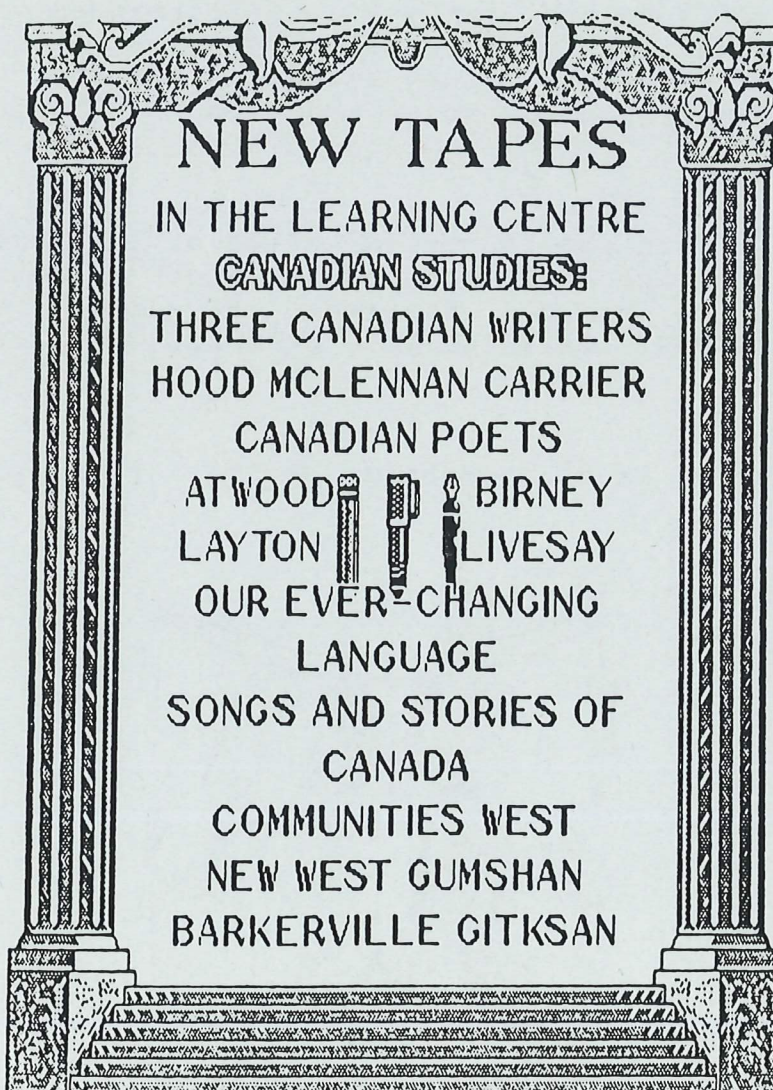
