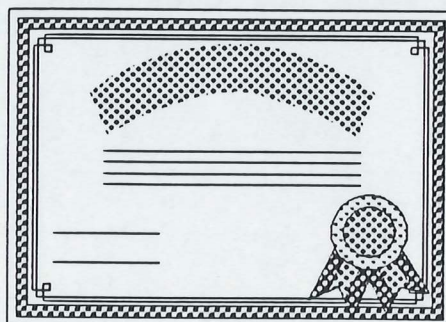
**...AND WELCOME CECILIA!**

**NEW ARRIVALS!**

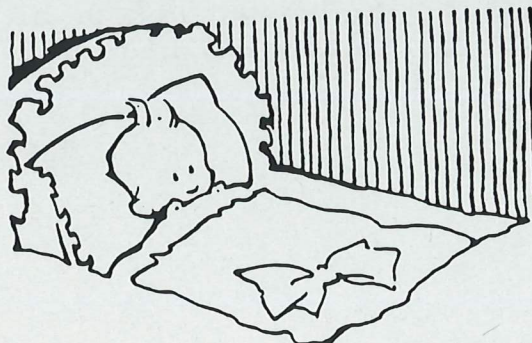
College Preparatory English is happy to announce the arrival of two baby boys:

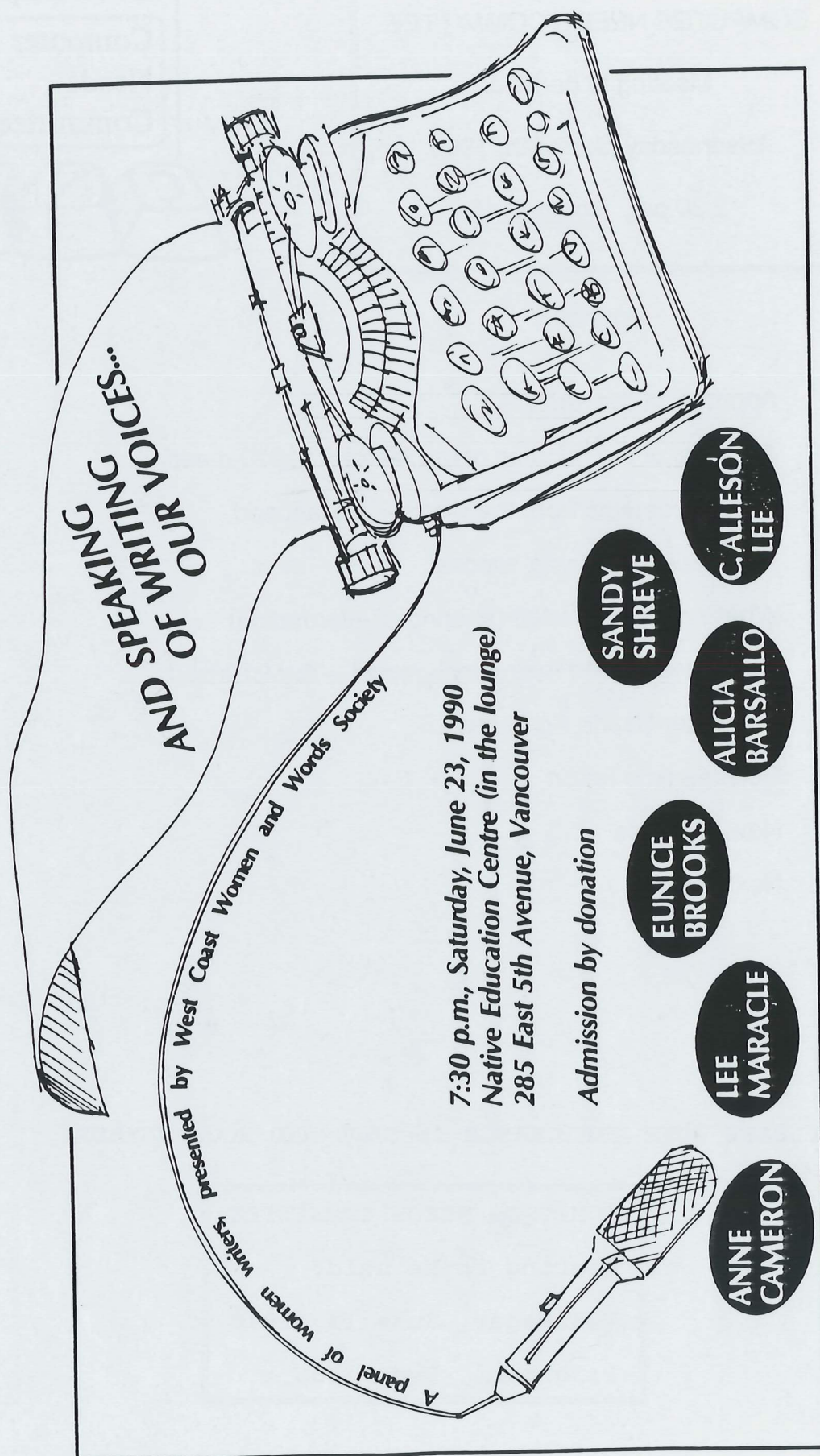




