## APPRECIATION DAY IN BTSD

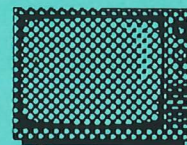

## VOICEMAIL HINTS

### Leaving messages for other users:

1. To bypass the mailbox greeting and begin leaving your message press any key other than 0 or \*. If you press 0 you will be transferred to the operator. The \* key identifies to VMail the mailbox owner is calling in.
2. To delete what you have recorded and rerecord your message press D (3 key) to discard.
3. To listen to your message before saving it to the mailbox press R (7 key) to review.
4. To append to your message before saving it to the mailbox press A (2 key) to append.
5. To mark your message urgent before saving it to the mailbox press U (8 key) for urgent.

You can also go directly into the mailbox of a user to leave a message by pressing 80 + local. Bypass the greeting by following procedure 1.

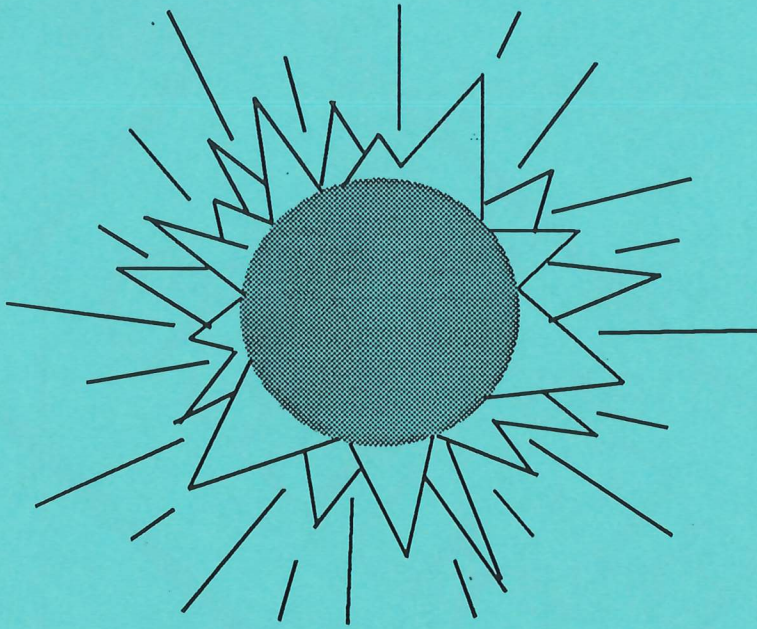
