VOICEMAIL HINTS

Leaving messages for other users:

- 1. To bypass the mailbox greeting and begin leaving your message press any key other than 0 or *. If you press 0 you will be transferred to the operator. The * key identifies to VMail the mailbox owner is calling in.
- 2. To delete what you have recorded and rerecord your message press D (3 key) to discard.
- 3. To listen to your message before saving it to the mailbox press R (7 key) to review.
- 4. To append to your message before saving it to the mailbox press A (2 key) to append.
- 5. To mark your message urgent before saving it to the mailbox press U (8 key) for urgent.

You can also go directly into the mailbox of a user to leave a message by pressing 80 + local. Bypass the greeting by following procedure 1.


