New Videos

We have acquired two popular films from CRM suitable for business and management programs. **Communication: The Nonverbal Agenda** (20 minutes, 1988, includes leader's guide) demonstrates different types of non-verbal behaviour, illustrates conflicts between verbal and non-verbal messages, and offers suggestions for consistency in both forms of communication. **The Power of Listening** (22 minutes, 1988, includes guide) identifies common impediments to the process of listening and offers techniques for sharpening listening skills.

Also for business is the classic BBC production of **Up the organization** (25 minutes, 1972, featuring Robert Townsend's unconventional ideas for running an organization).

Abuse of seniors is the subject of the NFB's **A House Divided** (35 Minutes, 1988, user's guide). Four moving, sensitive portraits show

the physical and psychological traumas inflicted on elders as well as neglect and financial exploitation. Suggestions for prevention and the need for community involvement are offered.

We will have many more new videos in all subject areas arriving over the next few months. Stay tuned for news!
