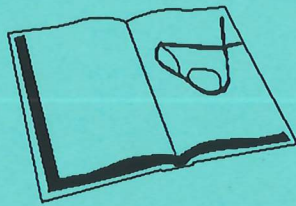

ERIC on CE-ROM

We now have ERIC on CD-ROM. For those who don't know, ERIC (Educational Resources Information Center) is a U.S. organization which compiles the definitive database on materials relating to the theory and practice of education in Canada and the U.S. All forms of items are found in the database: journal articles, reports, dissertations, etc.

Contact your liaison librarian to request a search on your topic of interest. As the library pays for subscription costs, your department will no longer be charged back for the search. You can have your search results on floppy disk as well. We can, in most cases, obtain more comprehensive and accurate results than available by searching ERIC through the UBC catalogue.

We will definitely be acquiring a public-access CD-ROM workstation in the near future for faculty and student use. You will then be able to conduct your own searches on CD-ROM, if you wish. Until then, librarians will do the search for you.

New AEMAC Catalogue

If you see video, check out our new AEMAC catalogue for high-quality, low-cost bargains that have been licensed for provincial post-secondary use. All subject areas are represented.

AEMAC is an acronym for the Advanced Education Media Acquisitions Centre. The Centre negotiates a licence (usually for a finite time period) with a distributor for duplication rights for B.C. colleges and universities. AEMAC fulfils some of the old PEMCE mandate.

No previews are available for these titles. However, most videos are quality items that have had to receive votes from the media librarians from at least five B.C. post-secondary institutions.

The B.C. Centre for International Education has notified us of the following employment opportunities in China.

Civil Engineering or Automobile Electronics

Changsha Communications University in Changsha, China has informed BCCIE that they are interested in employing instructors with a Master's Degree who can teach English, as well as automobile electronics, automobile diagnosis (specializing in internal combustion engines) or Civil Engineering. The position would commence September or October 1993 and finish in either December 1993 or June 30, 1994. The position requires 14 teaching hours per week plus curriculum preparation. The salary is \$1400 RMR* per month, 70% of which can be converted into US dollars. If the instructor can stay for both semesters, Changsha will provide a one-way ticket from Beijing or Shanghai to Canada plus \$1400 RMR* for travelling within China.

ESL Instructor

An instructor is required from September or October 1993 to June 30, 1994. The salary is 800 RMR* per month, 30% of which can be exchanged into US dollars. A one-way ticket will be provided from Beijing or Shanghai back to Canada.

* 1 RMR = \$0.2121 Cdn.
