New Videos

Health and the elderly once again feature prominently in this week's crop.

Health Care in Transition (59 min, 1992) is part 1 of a new series co-sponsored by the Registered Nurses Association of B.C. and Rogers Cable-Vision. It follows on the heels of the Royal Commission on Health Care and Costs and features interviews and discussions with all the major players in this area.

Late Adulthood (59 min, 1990) is one instalment of the critically acclaimed Seasons of Life series and focuses on the lives of ten seniors. Topics include retirement, lifestyles, physical change and decline, group homes and sexuality. A WQED production.

Living With Dying (27 min, 1991) demonstrates what it takes to care for a terminally ill family member. Albert has lymphoma (and tuberculosis, too) and we watch the day-to-day experiences and issues that involve himself, his

family and the nursing care-giver. An NFB production.

With Glowing Hearts (47 min, 1992) documents the process and final product of bringing together many of Canada's top pop musicians to record "O Canada". Catch all your faves: Luba, Helix, Rita MacNeil, Maestro Fresh Wes, Randy Bachman et al. Originally aired on CTV.

Often described as a kid's story for adults, Where the Wild Things Are (40 min, 1985) is an operatic adaptation of the book by Maurice Sendak. Features the Glyndebourne Festival Opera.

Other new videos include: Vancouver: World in a City (30 min, 1988) and The Group of Seven: A Northern Shore (28 min, 1990).


