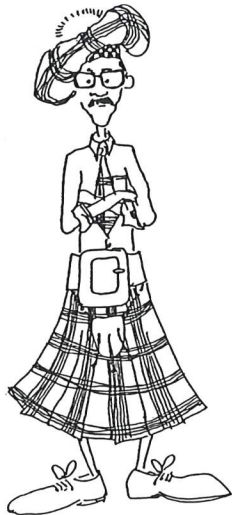
COMMUNITY COLLEGE EXCHANGE PROGRAM
