THE HEART OF THE CITY

Traces the development of the heart of the city and points out its weaknesses, but suggests ways of improvement. Cites Rome as a city destroyed by overexpansion and Amsterdam as an old city that has retained human values through regulation of waterways and land.

COSMIC ZOOM

An animated film that uses a boy rowing down a river as a departure point to take the viewer off our planet, through the solar system, and out towards the farthest reaches of space. The camera then returns through space to the boy in the boat and further within, to the smallest particle within a blood cell in his hand. Excellent.
