
Parking permits are available at the Cashier's desk in the Student Records Department, Monday - Friday to 17:00 and at the C.E. Office in the evenings or Saturdays.



## Re: Superannuation Commission Field Trips to the Lower Mainland

Representatives from the Superannuation Commission travel to the Lower Mainland once every month, except August, to meet employees and employers covered under the various pension plans that the Commission administers. These trips usually take place on either the first or second Thursday and Friday of each month. The interviews are scheduled to be held at the Government Agency in New Westminster Thursday afternoon and Government Personnel Services Division in downtown Vancouver Friday mornings.

The main objective of these visits is to provide personal counselling to employees who are contemplating retirement within the <u>next year or two</u>. However, the Superannuation Commission is also prepared to schedule interviews with employer representatives to discuss various features of the pension plans and the Commission policies and procedures.

If an employee is contemplating retirement and <u>only</u> requires an estimate of his/her pension, please have them write or telephone this office.

A supply of "Application for Half-Hour Personal Interview" forms is enclosed. If additional forms are required, please request them from this office. In order to ensure that a request for an interview will be considered, the request must reach the Superannuation Commission at least three months prior to the required interview date.

Upon receipt of the completed "Application for Half-Hour Personal Interview" form, the employee will be advised of the time and place of his/her appointment.

<u>N.B.</u> AVAILABLE FROM PERSONNEL I would appreciate receiving your comments and suggestions regarding the trios to the Lower Mainland, in order that both employees and employers can derive the maximum benefit from them.
