VCC has just installed Canada's first tapeless language lab at KEC. The Sony ZL 10 system uses digital voice memory instead of the traditional audio tape cassettes and offers students and instructors many advantages over current labs as it has the ability to rapidly review and re-arrange material thus giving teachers and students much more flexibility during lessons.
